ACCOMMODATION

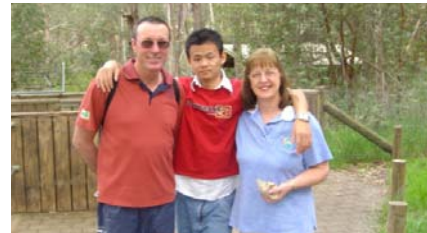
Adelaide is a '20 minute city' – as this is the average time it takes for most people to commute to or from the city centre. For this reason, you can find a variety of off-campus student accommodation located close to Trison Business College.

Student Hostel Accommodation

In hostel accommodation, each student has their own room with a bed, desk and cupboard/wardrobe. They share the kitchen, bathroom, laundry and lounge rooms with other students. The average cost is from \$75.00 per week and the student is normally required to pay 2 weeks' rent in advance. Usually, you will also have to pay an initial bond.

Full Board or Shared Accommodation

Full board accommodation provides students with a single room with bed and the option of having their meals provided. The cost of full board varies because different hosts provide different facilities, however prices generally begin from \$160.00 per week.



Shared accommodation offers the student a more personal type of accommodation. Students live as part of a family, and can use all living areas and facilities. Students usually have to cook their own meals and provide their own food and are expected to fit in with the family's lifestyle, and house rules. The price for shared accommodation does not include expenses for telephone calls and personal toiletries and ranges from \$75.00 - \$95.00 per week.

Rented House or Flat

This type of accommodation is more independent and allows students to choose whether to live alone or with fellow students. In many cases, you will need to sign a 12 month lease and provide a bond and references. In addition, you must buy your own food, prepare meals and complete other household tasks such as cleaning. Costs to rent a house are about \$180.00 per week for a 3 bedroom home in the suburbs. A 2 bedroom flat is approximately \$120.00 per week. However, these prices vary depending upon location.

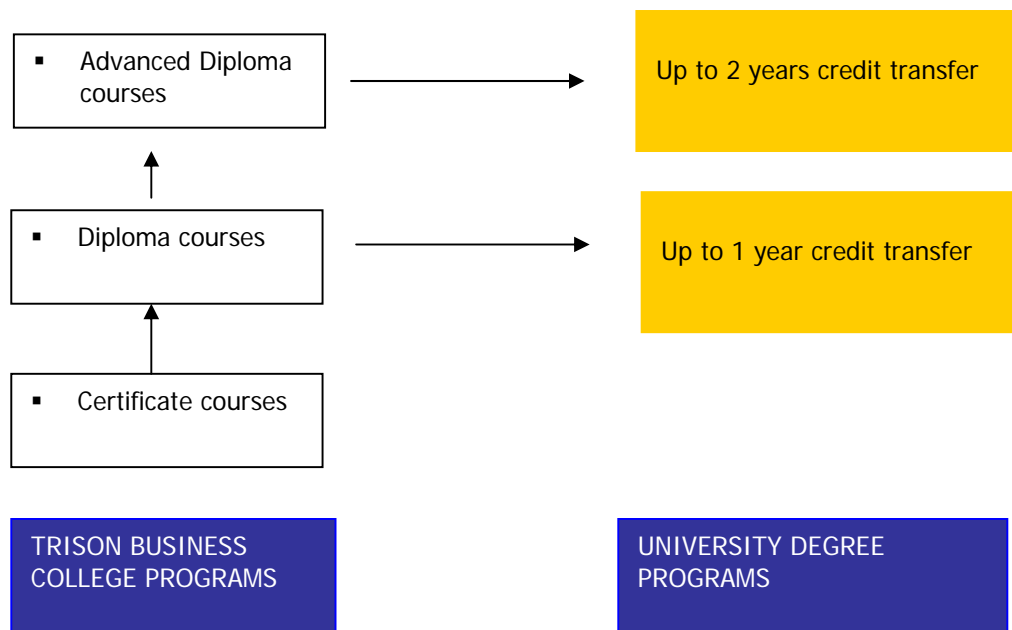

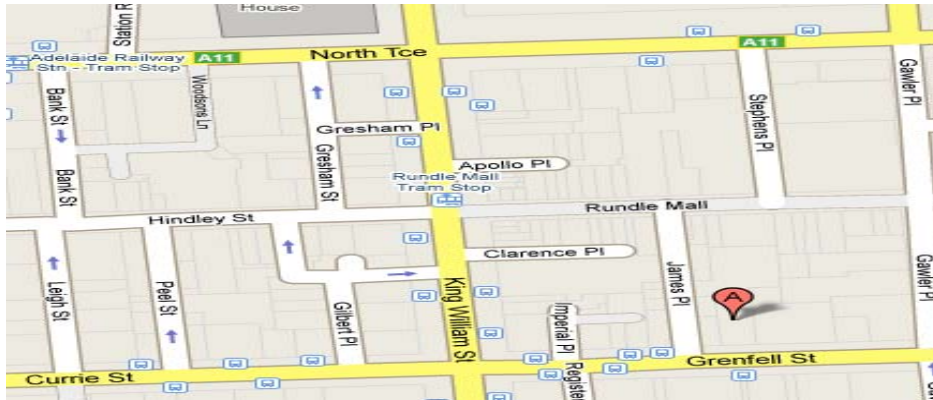

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

HOW TO APPLY

1. Complete and submit the enrolment form, either individually or in consultation with your education agent. Forms are available on our website, www.trison.com.au.
2. Once we confirm your enrolment, we will send you a Letter of Offer. If you accept, we will then notify the Department of Immigration and Citizenship (DIAC) and send them an Electronic Confirmation of Enrolment.
3. Attend your local DIAC office and apply for a Student Visa. A list of DIAC offices is available on-line at:

4. Make your travel, accommodation, and health cover arrangements. If you require, we are able to assist you with these arrangements.
5. Travel to Australia.
6. Pay your course fees, if you have not already done so.
7. Commence your course. Your first day will be spent undertaking an induction program, which provides assistance with shopping and setting up bank accounts. A tour of the local area will also be provided. Note that the induction program can be conducted prior to the actual commencement of the course, if requested.
